- **\$135 buy-in** (\$100 prize pool + \$35 administration) Fee includes any and all staffing/dealer fees, add-ons and rake.
- **\$250 buy-in** (\$200 prize pool + \$50 administration) Fee includes any and all staffing/dealer fees, add-ons and rake.
- Mega Satellites will play 25-minute levels. Registration will remain open until the start the start of level 5.
- Turbo Satellites will play 15-minute levels. Registration will remain open until the start the start of level 6.
- Players will start with 5,000 in tournament chips.
- Eliminated players may re-enter while registration remains open. All original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter. Players may forfeit their chips to re-enter.
- Any player who has not taken a hand by the start of the first break may be considered a “no show” and may have their chips removed from play and may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- There will be a 10-minute break approximately every two hours.
- The Tournament Director in his sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, and adjust the level lengths.
- **Prizes:** An entry into the \$1,700 buy-in Tulsa WSOP Circuit Championship Event plus \$20 cash will be awarded for every \$1,720 in the prize pool. Remaining money in the prize pool will be distributed to the next highest placing participant.
